All the owners have a full understanding that their puppy may test positive to Neospora when the litter is tested at 20 weeks of age in April. This test will simply determine if Ebony has infected any of them, if so, their owners gain the knowledge to **not allow** their dog to be treated for any ailment/illness with **drugs that may suppress their immune system**. If not, that means they were not infected by mum and were negative at the time of testing. Any dog can acquire Neospora from contaminated meat and a positive test means they will be positive for life, there is no way of knowing how or when Neospora caninum was contracted if it was not from their mother.




Introducing 'Fergie' (Miss Aqua)

On a river walk with Sally, both dogs got their paws wet.








A funny story from their carer




I have now fastened the panel to the crate properly. It could have been SO much worse!! I couldn't stop laughing when I read this and the carer responded with:
